RE: 34-Government Affairs Committee Report

As most of you know the legislature ended their session with passing a budget and without approving any of the property tax reform bills or ballot language. The Governor has called a special session for mid-April to get the budget finalized. No word yet on a special session for property tax reform or ballot language for a constitutional amendment.

Apart from those two items there were a lot of bills that did not pass which had statewide implications as well as several that did pass. The committee is still evaluating the final bills and will wait until the Governor signs or approves them to issue our final legislative report for the 2026 session.

The committee will continue to review recently filed bills and update our tracking accordingly. Please let us know if you hear of a specific bill with potential statewide implications so that we start tracking them.
